

## Biblical Evangelism: How It Worked in the Bible

Christians shared life, lived their faith, and stayed with people after belief.

### Presence — Being there before you speak

**Acts 2:46–47 (ESV):** Day by day they attended the temple together and broke bread in their homes, receiving food with glad hearts, praising God. And the Lord added to their number daily those being saved.

**Key Takeaway:** You can't speak into someone's life if you're not in it.

### Practice — Living it before explaining it

**1 Thessalonians 1:5 (ESV):** Our gospel came not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit, because you know what kind of men we proved to be among you.

**Key Takeaway:** If the life doesn't match the message, the message won't land.

### Perseverance — Staying with people after they believe

**Acts 2:42 (ESV):** They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

**Key Takeaway:** Sharing the gospel means sticking around.
